That comprises the subject matter of Part I of this book. Part II is the author's analysis of religious sentiment and morality, and covers areas such as the nature of religious dogma, and of god-head; as well as the ethical and quasi-ethical concepts often associated with the better known religions, and their antitheses, namely, altruism and selfishness, aggression and gentleness, pride and humility, justice and injustice.
